BUS PASSES 2018

Eligible students going into Year 3 in 2018

Students who are progressing from Year 2 to Year 3 do not need to reapply for a bus pass if they meet the following three conditions:

- Are continuing at the same school
- Are residing at the same address
- Have not been sent an expiry notification from Transport for NSW

If you do not meet the criteria you will need to update your information online at:

<https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/updateDetails>

If you have changed your address you will also need to advise the school of your new details.

Applications need to be submitted before 31st December 2017 to ensure students' entitlements are updated and their current card is not cancelled. If their application is submitted after 31st December 2017, the system will automatically cancel their card and a new one will need to be issued.

Students will receive their new travel pass at the commencement of the new school year in 2018.
