Dear Parents and Carers,

What a fabulous start we have had to the year. Classes are settled and with the additional transition times for Kindergarten, it is great going around to the classes to see how settled and engaged in learning they all are. Please remember that if you have a problem, the first person to help you will be your child's teacher. Building a strong relationship with them helps your child feel positive about school.

Please remember that students who are late or need to leave early need to be signed in and out by a responsible adult at the front office. If your child is sick and attends the doctor please ask for a medical certificate to supply to the school. It is mandatory that parents or carers supply the school with a note, or ring, (a note is preferable) explaining any absences from school.

If you intend to take extended leave you can apply to the office for an exemption. If you are travelling you will need to carry proof of this exemption with you.

P & C News

The first P&C meeting will held next Monday. The P & C do a great job raising funds for all the students at this school. We are hoping that many of our new parents and carers will come along and join the P&C and support the activities organised.

UPS Changeover

The office staff are busy getting our school administration ready to roll over into a new system. All schools will be moving to LMBR, our new finance and record program. Schools have used a system called OASIS, for many years and it is now outdated. The preparation for rollover requires all legal documents such as court orders to be scanned into the system as well as students health plans. There are many students whose parents have indicated they have an allergy or some other health issue. The office will be sending out letters to these parents, along with a Medical Action Plan that needs to be completed by the family doctor. These forms need to be completed in colour, which is why we are providing them. The colour coding is required under the Work Health and Safety Act that governs the school. If you visit your doctor and they write their own plan, it will be on the same mandatory form, please ask them for a colour copy for the school.

Student Discipline Policy

At UPS we uphold very high expectations with student behaviour. We expect ALL children to follow these basic rules

- Be Safe
- Be a Learner
- Be Respectful

If and when children do not follow these rules there are consequences. Depending on the behaviour, a child may receive just a warning, time out or spend time discussing what behaviours they need to stop and what behaviours they need to practice that are acceptable to all. Sometimes children will receive a lunchtime detention. We are looking at running some alternate programs at lunch time that some children will select for themselves and other students will be directed to. I will supply additional information as the term progresses and we get this all in place. Parents would normally receive a phone call or a letter if the students behaviour warrants a detention.

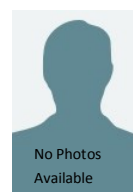
Mrs Sunderland is organising the 2017 Year 6 Graduation shirts. Shirts will cost \$35.
