Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to Term 2, I trust that you all had a safe and relaxing break.

I would like to publicly thank Justin for taking over as Principal for me in my absence. As always, he completed the role competently.

I enjoyed my cruise, the first one I have ever been on but am now behind in the work I should have completed last term. My problem, no-one else's.

I understand this is a very late thank you to the staff, students and Viliami for a fabulous Harmony Day. I was absent from school the last three days of that week as I was sick and did not get an opportunity to thank everyone for their hard work.

Thank you to those parents who were able to support the school and the community by bringing their children to Milton yesterday for the ANZAC ceremony. It was great to have a good group of students participate in the march as school representatives.

Just a reminder in regard to the drop of and pick up of students. Please use the pedestrian crossing, not only is this the safest option but provides a positive example for all students. If you are parked across the road, insist that your children also use the crossing. With the number of buses coming and going each afternoon it is a dangerous practise of some students to run out between buses to get to the car down the road.

Remember the road has a 40KPM limit in the morning and afternoon and that the "Lollipop Men", who work on the crossing do have the right to hold up stop signs, and you as drivers, need to comply with this.

Our Cross Country will run today. Students may need to bring a second pair of shoes and socks as the track is still wet in a couple of areas.

The administration staff are continuing their training ready for the roll over into LMBR from our current OASIS system.

We ask for your patience as we all learn how to operate the school within the system. One of the biggest changes that will impact on parents is the payment of excursions, etc and any possible reimbursements that may need to be claimed. The school, along with all other public schools in the state, will no longer have its "own" bank account and all accounts will be paid by a central system. The school will still operate within its own budget and be able to make decisions on how the allocated funds are spent but there will be no school cheques, only corporate ones.

Once we are organised, excursions will be paid by envelope or on line and money will be dropped in the letter box at the front office so ladies can receipt when they have time.

Parents have previously received a letter informing them of the changes but a quick reminder that:

Direct deposits will not be accepted into our current account as of **12th May**. This will allow the current account to be closed and the new one established.

Cash and Cheque payments between 17th and 22nd of May will not be accepted either to allow for the transition into the new account. Please ensure that you have made any outstanding cash or cheque payments before 17th May. From the 23rd May, cash and cheque payments can resume.

Our Market Day, last term was successful with an increase in money raised from 2016. The P&C will advise parents of the actual total. Thank you to those who assisted on the day and those who came and participated in the activities allowing the P&C to fund raise.

If you volunteer within a classroom please remember to sign in at the front office for Work Health and Safety reasons, this is mandatory.
