Dear Parents, Carers and Students,

Welcome back and a special welcome to our new families that have joined us this term. I hope every one had a safe and enjoyable break and students are all ready to continue their learning.

Returning Teachers

We have welcomed back two teachers, Ms Cooper and Mrs Finlay, who are returning part time from their maternity leave. Initially it was planned that they would team teach on a Year 1 and Kindergarten class but will now complete a variety of roles within the school, including releasing our beginning teachers.

Previously, temporary teachers in their first 2 years of teaching were not provided with support to complete their accreditation. This year, however, this changed and the school has been provided with additional funds and we are using part of this money to maintain continuity for students on the class with the same teacher they started the year with.

Our beginning teachers will use their additional time to work with a mentor, observe others and be observed, collect and annotate evidence to submit for their accreditation. Every beginning teacher must complete their accreditation demonstrating how they meet the Professional Teaching Standards and submit this, along with a report written by their supervisor to a state wide accreditation process.

Staff Development Day

Staff returned to school on Monday and had a very full program. The first session was looking at the school plan and how far we had progressed. Each group reported back on their progress and targets for the second half of the year.

Staff also participated in their first session of professional learning around Focus on Reading. This program has a focus on comprehension and the staff will continue training for the rest of the year. Much is revision but we are trying to set up a consistent approach for K-6 in all areas. Two of

our own staff, Michelle Morales and Kim D'Ombra have completed the "train the trainer" sessions and are delivering this to staff.

Education Week

Our school will be celebrating Education Week in Week 3 this term. Our assembly and open day will be on Tuesday August 1st. You will receive more information next week. All members of our local community are welcome to attend.

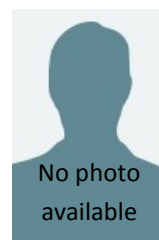

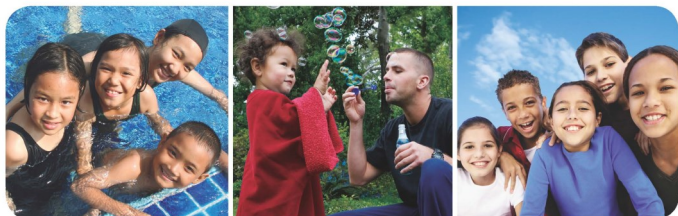
