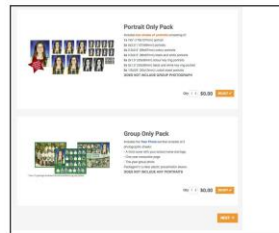

Dear Parents and Carers,

The UPS P&C and Tim Rudd (Pharmacist) from Capital Chemist have joined together to donate SPF30 Suncream and Sorbolene Cream to all 36 classrooms in the school.

A few mums spoke to me about having suncream readily accessible to their children before heading into the playground on hot days during Spring and Summer. We will place 1L Cancer Council suncreams in each of the classrooms, together with the sorbolene creams.

The reason for the sorbolene cream is due to many children having eczema and dry skin. Lots of parents lather their children with cream in the morning, but by the afternoon it's worn off and the scratching starts. It's also helpful to use during the winter months when their faces are dry from the cold air.

It is not the teachers responsibility to ensure students apply the cream, it's there for the students to use freely.

Please see the ingredients listed below. If your children are allergic to any type of ingredient please ensure you tell your child to refrain from using the products and inform your child's teacher.

Ingredients for Cancer Council everyday sunscreen SPF30 are:

Active Ingredients: Octocrylene 7% w/w, Butyl Methoxydibenzoylmethane 3.5% w/w, 4-Methylbenzylidene Camphor 3% w/w, Phenylbenzimidazole Suphonic Acid 2.5% w/w. **Preservatives:** Phenoxyethanol

Ingredients for Kenkay Skin Relief Sorbonne

Purified water, Glycerin, liquid paraffin, white soft paraffin, cetearyl alcohol, ceteareth-20, p-chloro-m-cresol.

Volunteer Ethics Teachers Required

Dear Parents and Carers,

Ethics classes are available at Ulladulla Public School as an option for children who don't attend Special Religious Education (SRE/scripture).

Ethics classes support children in developing skills in ethical reasoning, critical thinking, collaborative enquiry and how to support their arguments with evidence. The lesson materials have been approved by the Department of Education.

We do not have enough volunteer ethics teachers at Ulladulla Public School to meet the demand for classes in 2018. The more children and stages we have requests for, the more teachers are needed.

Volunteering is a great way to engage with the school. Volunteer ethics teachers do not need a background in teaching or ethics, just a willingness to learn how to deliver classes. They must complete a two day workshop and other online training and accreditation requirements. The approved lesson materials are provided. Ethics teachers must commit to conduct classes each week at the school during school terms for at least one year.
