If you ordered online by the advertised due date (23/03/2018) you will be receiving your order this week! If you ordered online after the due date unfortunately you will have to wait till next term to receive your order as it will not be posted out in time.

## Have you provided the office with up to date information?

We welcome information from parents about your child's health, even if you are not requesting specific support from the school. Our school asks for medical information when you enrol your child. It is important that you let us know if your child's health care needs change, or if a new health condition develops.

Information about allergies, medical conditions such as Asthma, Diabetes and Epilepsy may require health care plans to be developed. Please provide any information regarding medical conditions in writing to the school, this will greatly assist our school in planning to support your child's health and wellbeing.



An additional reminder to parents to notify the school of any changes to your family circumstances, contact details and the contact details of your nominated emergency contacts as soon as possible. A 'Change of details' form is available from the front office or you can download a form from our website [by clicking here.](#)

We appreciate your assistance in this regard and assure you that any information you provide the school will be stored securely. Information will only be used to support your son or daughter's needs or as otherwise required by law.

## Parent Online Payments

It is now possible for parents to make online payments to the school for amounts owing for students, via a secure payment page hosted by Westpac. Payments can be made using either a Visa or MasterCard credit or debit card, and can be made via computer, tablet or mobile phone. The payment page is accessed from the front page of the schools website by selecting \$ Make a payment.



Items that can be paid include voluntary school contributions, subject contributions, excursions, sales to students and creative and practical arts activities (these include band, drama and dance). There is also a category called 'Other' this to cover items not covered in the previous headings, Other can be used to make a complete payment of a school invoice.

When you access the \$ Make a payment you must enter:

- the students name, and
- class and reference number OR
- the students name, and
- date of birth.

These details are entered each time you make a payment as student information is not held within the payment system. There is also the option to enter the Student Registration Number and Invoice number if you are aware of them, these are optional fields OR there is also the option to enter the Student Registration Number and Invoice number these are not used at our school, please leave blank.

This is a secure payment system hosted by Westpac to ensure that your credit/debit card details are captured in a secure manner, these details are not passed back to the school.

You have the ability to check and change any details of the payment before the payment is processed. Receipts can be emailed and/or printed.

Details of the payments are passed daily to the school where they will be receipted against your child's account. As a receipt has been issued from the payment page a further receipt will not be issued by the school.

Forest Ferals, along with parents and teachers, make up Ulladulla Public School's Environmental Council.

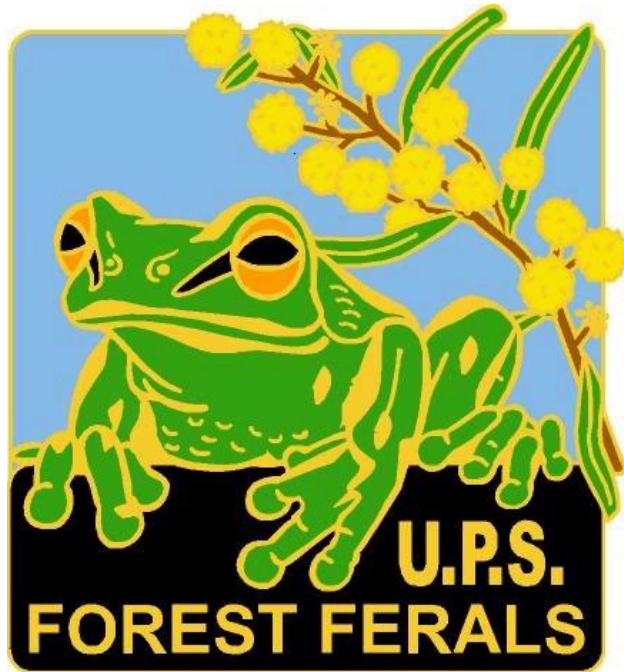
**All students from Years K-6 enrolled at our school are members of the 'Forest Ferals'.**
