National Simultaneous Storytime 2018

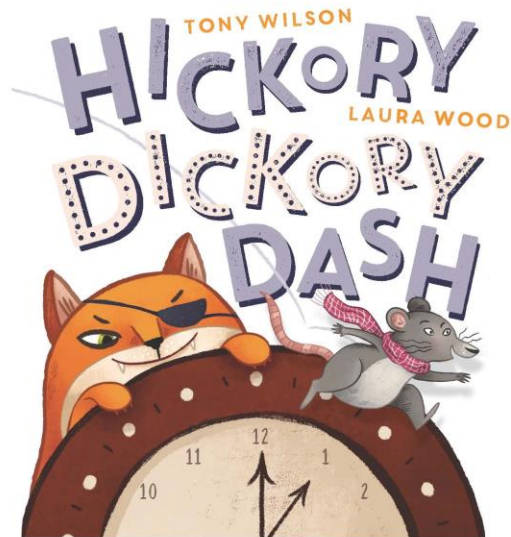
