National Simultaneous Storytime 2018



As a way to celebrate *Library and Information Week* (21-27 May) UPS has registered to take part in **National Simultaneous Storytime 2018**.

National Simultaneous Storytime (NSS) is held annually by the Australian Library and Information Association (ALIA). Every year a picture book, written and illustrated by an Australian author and illustrator, is read simultaneously in libraries, schools, pre-schools, childcare centres, family homes, bookshops and many other places around the country. It is a colourful, vibrant, fun event that aims to promote the value of reading and literacy, using an Australian children's book that explores age-appropriate themes, and addresses key learning areas of the National Curriculum for Kindergarten to Year 6.

This year the chosen text is *Hickory Dickory Dash* which is written by Tony Wilson and illustrated by Laura Wood.

Our school has also won one of fifty book packs worth \$100 by registering early for the NSS, which Paige R (5J), Tyler K (1S), Tamati G (KO), Charlotte A (5J) and Ava C (5T) are excitedly holding below.



On Wednesday 23rd May at 11am the students will catch up with their buddy class and enjoy listening to *Hickory Dickory Dash* as thousands of other children do to simultaneously across Australia.

Parent Online Payments

It is now possible for parents to make online payments to the school for amounts owing for students, via a secure payment page hosted by Westpac. Payments can be made using either a Visa or MasterCard credit or debit card, and can be made via computer, tablet or mobile phone. The payment page is accessed from the front page of the schools website by selecting \$ Make a payment.



Items that can be paid include voluntary school contributions, subject contributions, excursions, sales to students and creative and practical arts activities (these include band, drama and dance). There is also a category called 'Other' this to cover items not covered in the previous headings, Other can be used to make a complete payment of a school invoice.

When you access the \$ Make a payment you must enter:

- student name
- class name
- date of birth

These details are entered each time you make a payment as student information is not held within the payment system. There is the option to enter the Student Registration Number and Invoice number, these are not used at our school, please leave blank.

This is a secure payment system hosted by Westpac to ensure that your credit/debit card details are captured in a secure manner, these details are not passed back to the school.

You have the ability to check and change any details of the payment before the payment is processed. Receipts can be emailed and/or printed.

Details of the payments are passed daily to the school where they will be receipted against your child's account. As a receipt has been issued from the payment page a further receipt will not be issued by the school.
