It will be important that you read the key on the front page of the reports and to know that a 'sound' grade means that students are meeting expected outcomes for that grade at that point in time. We will be looking to gain your views on the new report format so that the school reports what parents are wanting to know. Please help us to build better reporting systems for our community by completing the survey that will be attached to the reports when they are sent home.

This week will be another eventful week as we host our Primary Athletics Carnival, not to mention our grade finals for the talent expo. The talent expo always produces a wonderful showcase of our students and draws a large lunch time crowd to watch the acts on offer. Nationally Consistent Collection of Data – School Students with Disability

All government and non-government schools in Australia are required to participate in the annual Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (the national data collection). The first national data collection took place in selected schools in October 2013. Over 2013 to 2015, schools participated in the national data collection under a phased implementation approach. Since 2015, all Australian schools have completed the data collection. This marks a significant achievement by all government, Catholic and independent education sectors. The national data collection is based on the professional judgement of teachers about their students with disability and the level of adjustment they receive to access and participate in education on the same basis as other students. The national data collection assists schools to:

- gain a greater understanding of their students with disability and how they can be best supported
- formally and consistently recognise the supports and adjustments provided to students with disability
- develop the professional judgement of school teams in identifying the need for adjustments for students with disability, rather than relying on a medical or clinical diagnosis alone
- review their learning programs , teaching, support systems and processes to continually improve educational outcomes students with disability.
